

How to Paint Your Continental Built House with Three Colors

In Wildcat Ridge the Falcon built homes are designed well for a three color scheme, however, the Continental built homes are only designed for a two color scheme (no accent) so it is a little harder to put three colors on and make it look good. Of course you may always use the two colors (body and trim) from the new schemes to stay with a two color scheme.

Below are descriptions of three accepted methods for using a three color scheme on a Continental built home.

- ◆ One way is to paint the body one color, the trim around the garage door, widows, doorframes, put the third color on the trim along the roofline, and door
- ◆ A second way is to paint the body, put the second color on trim, gutters, windows, and doorframes, paint third color (usually a slightly darker version of the body) on a vent, or other small area above a garage or a architectural piece between first and second floors, and door
- ◆ The third way is to put the third color on shutters and door. This example the third color should be in the same color family as the body and trim. An example of that would be, 8713W for the body, 8710W for the trim and 8712W for the accent. Be careful not to put too dark or too stark a color on the shutters. Example: 8713W for the body, 8710W for the trim, 8505D for the Shutters. It's not the color combination as much as it won't work in most communities.
